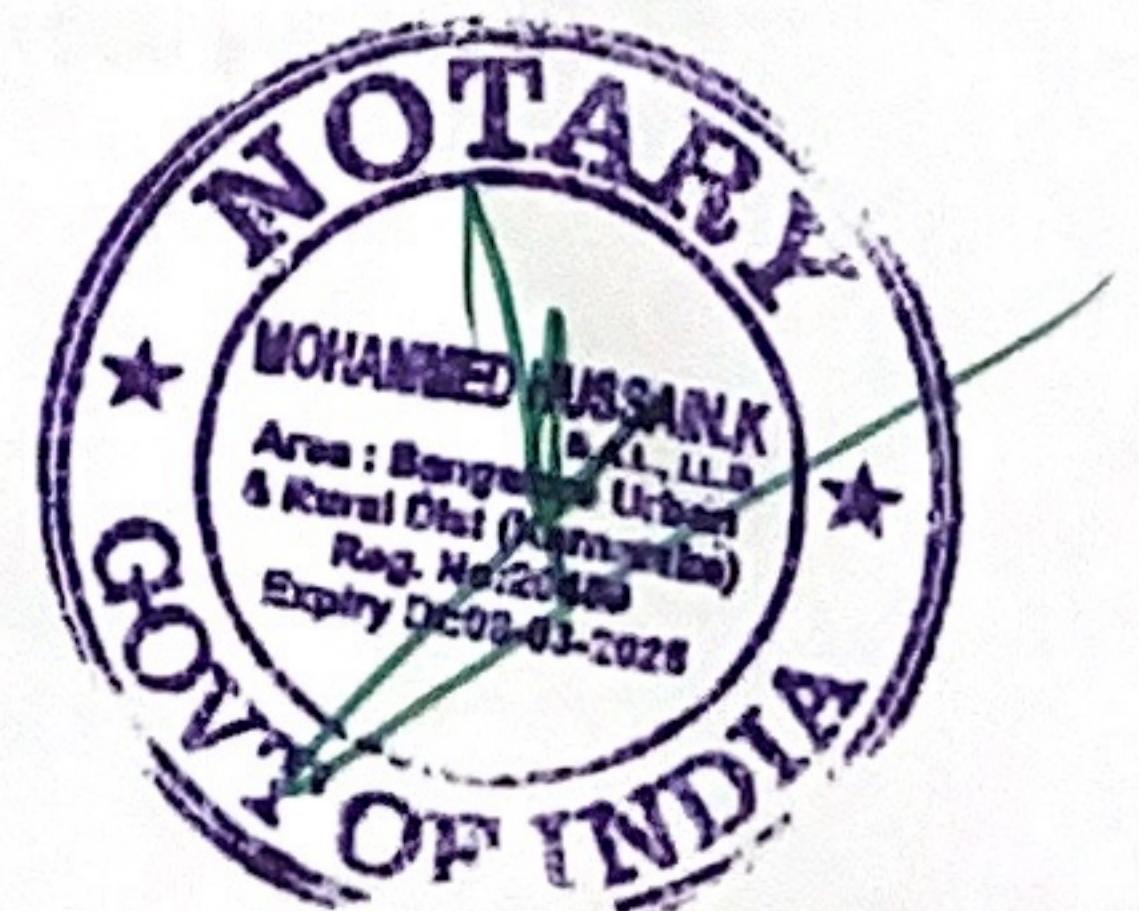

Conditions:

1. The school is registered under the Child Rights Education Act, 2009, and the Karnataka Education Act, 1983 and in accordance with the rules framed there under, and the accreditation is renewed up to the registered class. Apart from these classes, additional classes and extra sections are not permitted.
2. The school shall function under the rules framed under the Karnataka Education Act-1983 and the Child Rights Education Act-2009.
3. Child Rights to Education Act-2009 to reserve 25% seats for weaker section children under the rules framed there under. The government has the authority to register the mixed seats under RTE for the schools covered by RTE. [Government has made rules to facilitate the enrollment of children in neighboring schools where their parents live, according to which, if there are educational institutions funded by the government, children will be enrolled in] Otherwise, private schools enroll children enrolled by the government and allow them to continue their education up to the primary level. Allow these children to continue their education without any discrimination imagining,
4. Fees of children enrolled under RTE rules as described in condition : 3 will be released by the Government as per rules. Therefore charging any fee from these children was prohibited.

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5. The school and the school management are prohibited from collecting any kind of capitation fee and donations from the parents either at the time of enrollment or later.
6. The school/governing body shall publish the information of fees collected from the parents of the children in their school as tuition fee vide State Government Notification No: ED:31:PGC, dated:27.07.2019 27.07.2019 in the departmental web let and on the school notice board. No fee
7. The School/Governing body enroll the students within the period fixed by the Govt.
8. The school/governing body cannot refuse enrollment against the following factors
 - (i) Due to lack of age proof
 - (ii) on the basis of caste, religion, place of birth, language,
 - (iii) if admission is sought after the extended period of admission
9. RTE Code and Rules To carry out all safety measures as per Karnataka Education Act and Rules. [Fire safety and Kannada safety certificate from concerned authorities and child learning safety as per KSCPCR and ACPCR Select PDF F
10. The School / Governing Body is as follows
 - (i) No admitted child shall be held back from any class or expelled from the school until he completes primary education and secondary education in the school.
 - (ii) No child should be subjected to physical or mental abuse.
 - (iii) No child shall be required to pass any board examination till completion of primary education.
 - (iv) Every child who completes primary education is issued a certificate as prescribed under RTE Rule-21 and Karnataka Education Act and Rules.
 - (v) As per the provisions of the RTE Act and Rules and the Karnataka Education Act and Rules the school shall also accommodate children with special needs / special children who have should also be included.
 - (vi) Appointed teachers as prescribed in RTE Code and Rules and Karnataka Education Act and Rules and Government Orders for Primary and High School Teachers.
 - (vii) Salary and allowances payable to teachers and terms and conditions of service shall be as prescribed by the State Government and shall be paid to teachers through Government Notification Provident Fund (P) and Payable Bank and other emoluments and shall be subject to Employee State Insurance(ESI).
 - (viii) The teacher shall perform the duties prescribed under Section-24(1) of the Act and the RTE Act and Rules and Rule-17 of the Karnataka Education Act and Rules. And Mali does not indulge himself in private tuitions for trekking considerations.
11. Adherence to the academic state curriculum and state text books to which the school is affiliated.
12. The school shall maintain the norms and standards as specified in Section 19 of the Karnataka Education Act. Appointment of departmental staff as prescribed in the Karnataka Education Act and Rules.
13. School buildings and other basic facilities associated with the school should not be given over to any commercial activities or political and non-educational activities during the day or night.
14. The school shall not be run for the benefit of any person or group or association.
15. Get the school audited by a Chartered Accountant and submit the copy to the Deputy Director /Field Education Officer by the end of June every year.
16. The School shall follow the Language Policy as per Government Notification [Kannada Language Policy 2016).
17. Governing body and teachers to act as per RTE Act and Karnataka Education Act and Rules.

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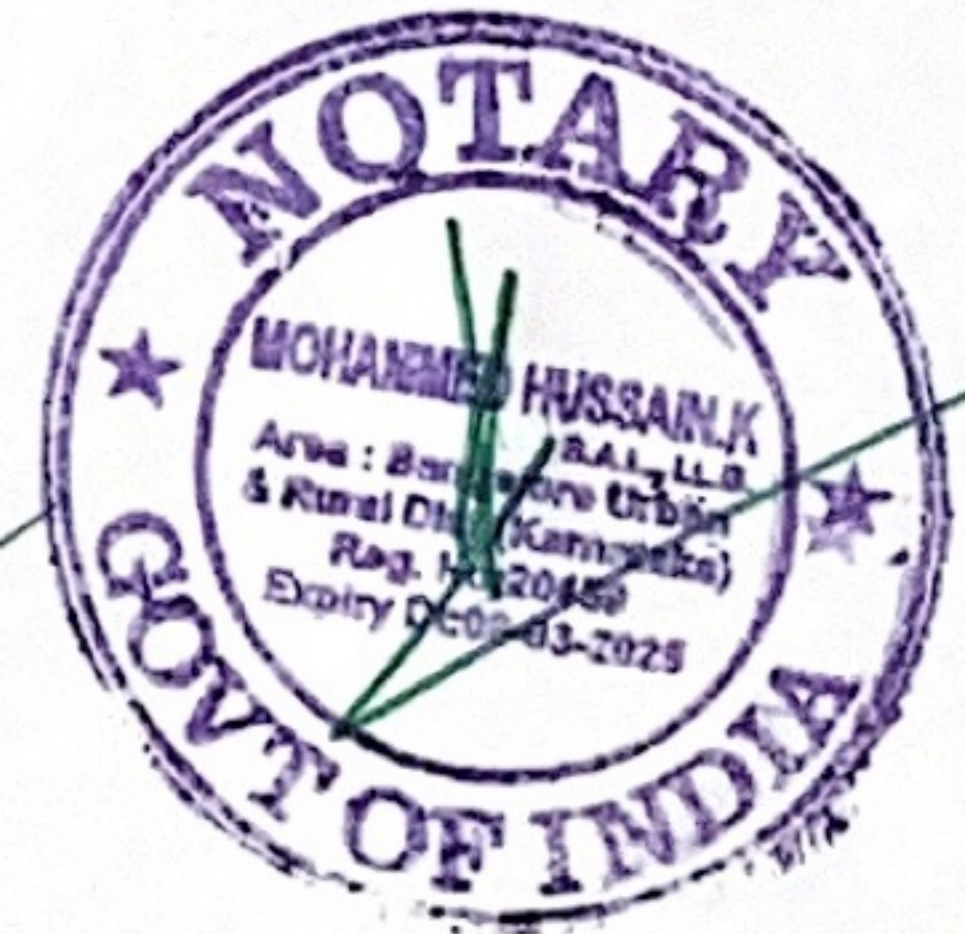
18. The school / governing body shall strictly follow the rules and directives of the Government and the Department.
19. Mandatory uploading of school information in S.A.T.S. by the end of March every year.
20. Violation of the above conditions will result in the cancellation of the recognition of the school as per the rules framed under the RTE Act 2009 and the Karnataka Education Act 1983.
21. After the school accreditation process is completed, the entire document/information in the application submitted online by the governing body will be made available for public viewing on the departmental website.
22. Violation of the above conditions will result in the cancellation of the recognition of the school as per the rules framed under the RTE Act
